

Articulation Agreement
Between
Washtenaw Community College
Criminal Justice Associate in Arts Degree
and
Concordia University Ann Arbor
Accelerated Degree Program
Bachelor of Arts, Management of Criminal Justice

I. Introduction

This agreement establishes a formal articulation agreement between Washtenaw Community College and Concordia University Wisconsin. It is based on a thorough review and analysis of the **Criminal Justice** – Associate in Arts Degree Washtenaw Community College in relation to the Bachelor of Arts curricula in **Management of Criminal Justice** at Concordia University Ann Arbor. This agreement will facilitate the admission of qualified Washtenaw Community College students into a Bachelor of Arts degree program at Concordia University Ann Arbor by guaranteeing the transfer of academic coursework according to the attached listing of courses.


II. Terms of the Agreement

- A. Qualified Washtenaw Community College students who meet admission criteria of Concordia University Ann Arbor, and apply for admission to Concordia University Ann Arbor are guaranteed transferability of academic coursework according to the attached listing of courses.
- B. Qualified Washtenaw Community College students are those who have successfully completed the Criminal Justice – Associate in Arts degree .
- C. Students who fail to meet the requirements outlined in point B are not guaranteed transferability of coursework as set forth in this agreement but instead will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- D. To earn a baccalaureate degree the student must earn a total of 128 credits as specified in the attached listing of courses. Students must complete a minimum of 36 credits at Concordia to satisfy the residency requirement to earn the baccalaureate degree.


III. The Agreement

This agreement becomes effective upon the signatures of both parties and shall continue in effect unless either party wishes to void the agreement. The agreement may be voided only in writing; termination of the agreement should become effective sixty (60) days after written notice is given. Washtenaw Community College and Concordia University Ann Arbor will consider in good faith any amendments proposed by either party; however, the agreement may only be amended in writing, signed by both parties.




