CHECK THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR THE CARL PERKINS VOCATIONAL GRANT:

- ✓ You must be enrolled in an occupational program or course(s)
- ✓ You must fit one of the following categories: Single Parent, including single pregnant woman, displaced homemaker, non-traditional training and employment participant, economically disadvantaged, academically disadvantaged, individual with a disability or individual with limited English proficiency.
- ✓ You are required to apply for federal financial aid.
- ✓ Grants are based on availability of funds. According to federal guidelines, those with the greatest need will be given priority. Academic progress for the award of this grant requires that students successfully complete 75% of registered classes with a 2.0 GPA or higher.
- ✓ All applications must be complete with verification of income. Other documentation such as a childcare invoice and book price list may also be required.
- ✓ Compass test and/or career assessment may be required.
- ✓ According to Federal guidelines, those with the greatest financial need will have priority
